

2021 Irish Championship Circuit Racing

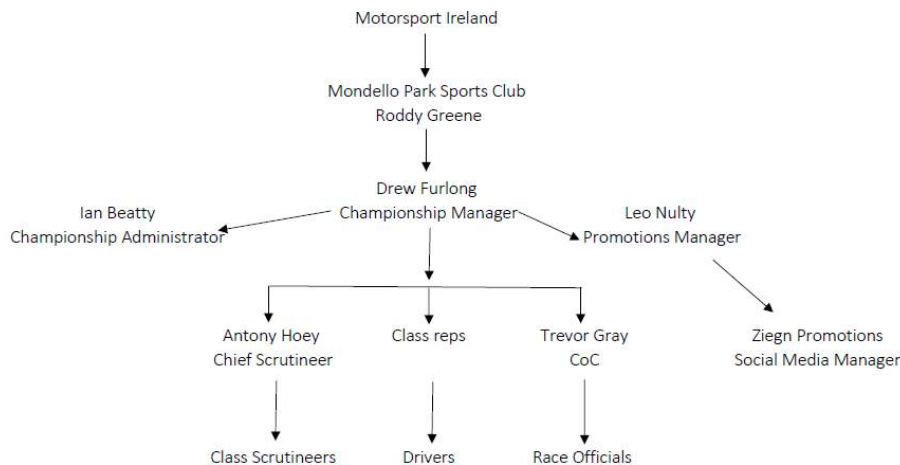
The Irish Championship Circuit Racing is organised and promoted by Mondello Park Sports Club (MPSC) in agreement with Motorsport Ireland (MI) and is governed in accordance with the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA).

MPSC were appointed as organisers and promoters following the issue of an Expression of Interest document by Motorsport Ireland in July 2020. MPSC submitted a comprehensive plan which outlined a 3 - 5 year plan for the management and promotion of our sport. MPSC aims to bring the competitor into the central focus of what we do and that it will:

- Anticipate competitor needs and create a product that will meet future expectations
- Collect competitor feedback through regular engagement
- We will be easily accessible be it on race day or otherwise
- Provide a proactive service to the competitor where they will have the resources available to have a safe and enjoyable experience
- We will look beyond the race entry and build brand loyalty with the competitor
- Consistently apply the rules in a fair manner
- Apply the RESPECT values in how we manage the championship

MPSC Organising Committee

MPSC has implemented a defined organisational structure with defined roles and responsibilities. Below is a schematic of the organisational structure and shows the names of personnel appointed to each role and gives all those involved in our championship the lines of communication for any issues to be resolved.

Test Days

Event timetables will be scheduled to ensure compliance with Covid regulations to ensure the number of competitor and team staff are kept to a minimum. This will mean that where possible qualifying and racing will take place on one day only. Race Organisation

One of the first tasks the Organising Committee undertook was to review the structure and personnel involved in the running of events. This includes staff in Race Admin, Race Control, Scrutineers and the Judicial system. The ICCR will now benefit from a team of dedicated officials who, subject to availability, will be in attendance at all events. This will ensure continuity of service and will allow a much-improved competitor experience at all of our events.

COVID-19 Protocol

The aim of ICCR Organising Committee is to start the 2021 season without placing personnel, officials, teams, drivers, media, sponsors, or any other people in jeopardy due to the ongoing threat of COVID-19. The Committee has produced a COVID-19 Protocol and is available on the ICCR website in the Events section. This document is intended to provide a framework to allow the ICCR to recommence. The information and instructions may be amended by

- Legal requirements from the Government
- Further instructions issued by the Local Authority
- Regulations put in place by our governing bodies, Motorsport Ireland or Motorsport UK for events at Kirkistown and Bishopscourt
- Requirements issued by Mondello Park or the Organising Committee

Competitors are advised to read the COVID-19 Protocol prior to each event and ensure that all team personnel in attendance at an event has been given a copy and understand the requirements detailed in the document. Event Officials will be monitoring competitors and teams to ensure compliance, with any competitors or his personnel found to be in contravention being reprimanded, fined or may be asked to leave the venue.

Race Entries

Entries will be accepted from all competitors who have registered for the championship via each Class Registrar. Closing dates for entries will be the Friday of the week prior to the week of the event. Due to COVID-19 restrictions and the additional planning required when running an event under the current restrictions late entries will be accepted only until the Wednesday prior to an event. There will be an additional late entry fee of €50. No entries will be accepted after the Wednesday prior to the event under any circumstances. All entries must be booked and paid in advance as no cash will be taken on the day. Entries can be completed online at:

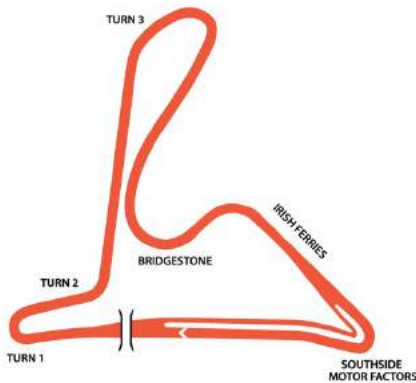

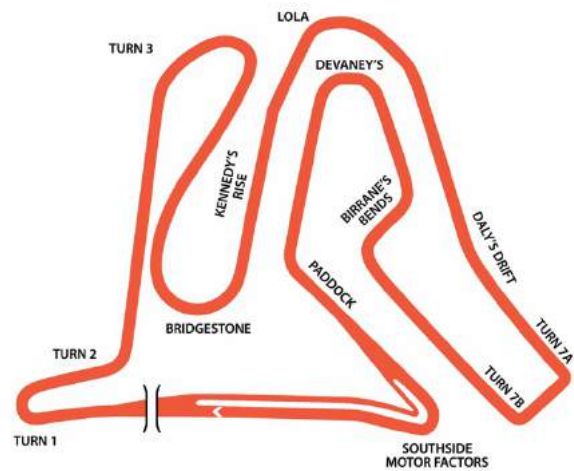
